There shall be no external examinations and the students shall be assessed as per the scheme of Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for the total marks prescribed.

Students who have opted Hindi/Tamil/Malayalam/French in Multi Languages Course should not choose the same course in SEC – III.

d. SEC-IV: Department Component

One Value Added (Skill based) Course is offered by the department during the VI Semester for all students as prescribed by the Board of Studies concerned for which examination shall be conducted at the end of the semester.
