- ❖ Two faculty members were qualified with NET of UGC. Three faculty members received Ph.D and six members got M.Phil degree.

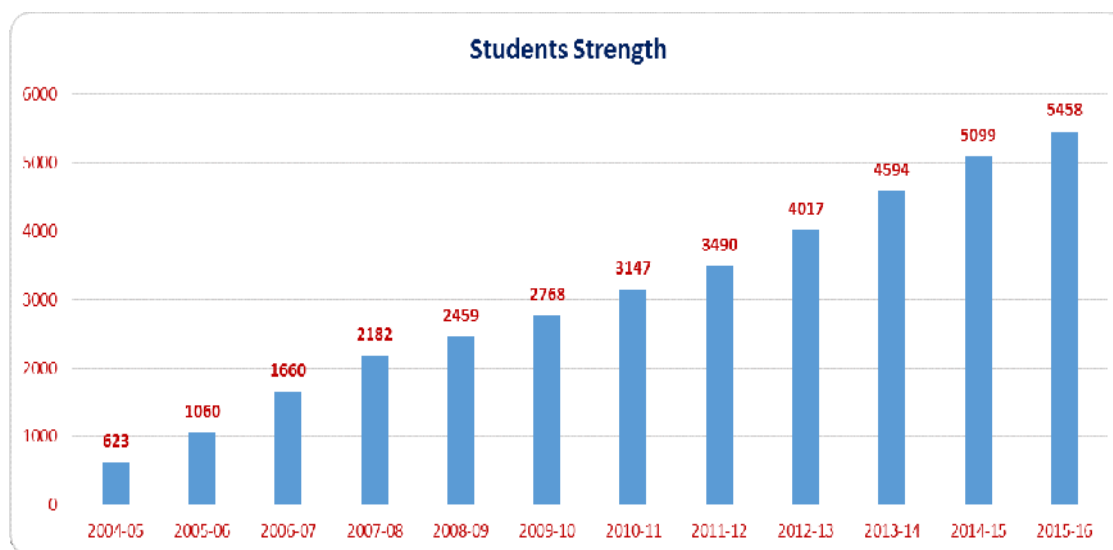

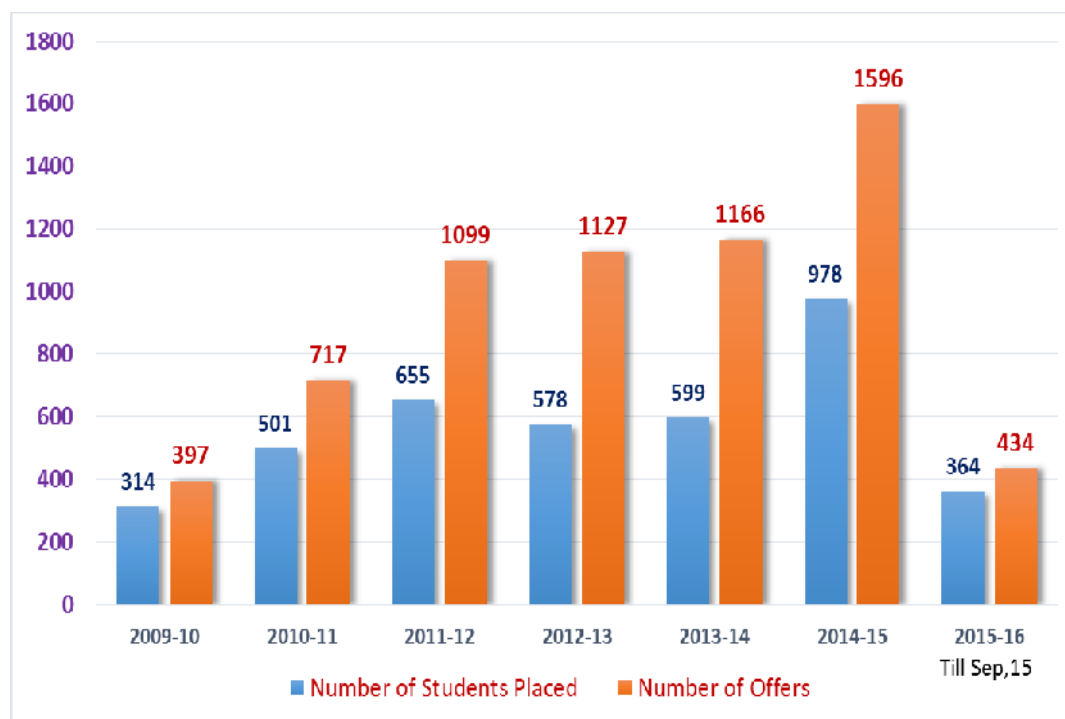
