Significant Contributions

- **Mapping of Syllabus** to Professional Standards and Industry Needs – B.COM (PA) programme has been mapped with Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, New Delhi by underlining the need for CA foundation and to simulate Syllabus in gaining professional Knowledge in Finance.
- **Computerization of Outcome Based Education and use of OMR Sheets** in evaluation in examination cell which help to scan the mark sheet and display the corresponding results in order to save time and maintain accurateness.

- **Eco Initiative** – SKASC bagged All India 4th place in Swachtha Ranking to spread awareness on the importance of cleanliness in their surroundings and regular societal activities are conducted by students as part of their curriculum to fulfill our Prime Minister Dream of clean India.
- **Best Local Chapter in NPTEL** - More than 5000 students and 300 faculty members have enrolled for NPTEL online courses so far. As recognition SKASC has been awarded as Best Local Chapter by NPTEL in terms of enrollment and percentage of passes.
- **Placement offer** from Core Companies – SKASC conducts pre-placement training sessions to equip students with relevant skills in their respective fields. About 90 - 95% aspiring students were placed in reputed companies every year.
- The **IQAC** monitors the activities of the college through various committees.
- **Periodical meetings** were held to collect data pertaining to the various activities like organising of lectures, seminars and other programmes. Further IQAC prepared Feedback reports regarding the events in the college.
