74. SWASTIK RURAL CAMP 2023 at IKKARAI BOLUVAMPATTI: Day 1 – 17/03/2023 – Inauguration: On the first day, the trainees reached the camp site by around 11:00 AM in one of the college buses. Earlier that day, a team had already reached the camp site and made everything ready before the rest of the trainees reached. Upon reaching, the arrangements for the inauguration were met by one group while the others went to mobilise and inform the public about the camp and the reason for our visit. The inauguration began by 12:00 Noon. There were three special guests that day. One among them was Mr. Samuel Churchill, the founder of the Leaders desk. The others were Mr. Santhosh Kumar, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology, Sri Krishna Arts and Science College, Coimbatore – 08 and the Panchayat President of Ikkarai Boluvampatti, Mr. Sathanantham. Mr. Arvin Krishna from I MSW welcomed the gathering with his elegant dance performance. Post the regular inauguration formalities; Mr. Samuel Churchill was the first to speak. He spoke about the importance of tribal camp aspect as a part of curriculum among social work trainees and also said about the connection a social worker can make with the public through these kinds of camps. He spoke about what the trainee’s attitude and responsibilities should be in a rural camp. He was felicitated by Dr. M N Krishnadas, Assistant Professor, Department of Social Work, Sri Krishna Arts and Science College, Coimbatore – 08. Mr. Santhosh Kumar, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology, Sri Krishna Arts and Science College, spoke about the importance of a balanced food menu, healthy diet and staying fit. He asked the trainees to share those ideas with the village people in the upcoming days. He was felicitated by Assistant Professor of Department of Social Work Mrs. Sangavi. Then the Panchayat President Mr. Sathanantham spoke a few words appreciating the trainees' works and wished them the best for the camp and also their lives. The whole inauguration program was over by 01:00 PM and the trainees dispersed for lunch. Post lunch, the trainees left in small groups to inform the public about the next day's program; that is the free eye and general camp in collaboration with Karpagam hospital. Dr. M N Krishnadas spoke to the trainees about the importance of mobilisation and Ms. Dharunika, the student

coordinator informed the trainees about the details that are to be shared with the villagers. The entire village was almost covered that day by the trainees. The public were very welcoming and interested to know the activities throughout the camp days. The trainees left the camp site by 03:00 PM. The trainees learnt about the village and had one more experience in mobilising people. The villagers promised to visit the medical camp for the next day and they also extended their help of any kind in the camp centre.

75. Day 2 – 18/03/2023 – Eye and General Medical Camp: During the second day of the camp, the trainees reached the camp site by 10:15AM. Trainees who were already there in the camp site helped in arranging chairs and tables for consultation as the day was focused on providing medical assistance to the villagers. The medical camp was in collaboration with Karpagam Hospital, Coimbatore. A total of four doctors and four nurses, along with a public relation officer, one Mr. Parthiban and a driver had come on behalf of the hospital. As soon as the trainees reached the place, they were split into several teams to make the work easier. A team stayed with the doctors to help them with registration and other work. Other trainees were mobilising door to door and interacting with the community people in the village. The trainees asked the community people to make full use of the free camp. In the process the trainees had an exposure to mobilise people and learned to interact better with the community. A lot of people with medical intervention needs were identified that day. The medical camp included free eye check-up and general body check-up. During the day, it was identified that there were a lot of people who were in need of spectacles and cataract surgery. For general body check-up, the beneficiary's vitals such as blood pressure were checked. The doctors then interacted with the beneficiaries to identify the medical needs if any. The beneficiaries were recommended medications and other lifestyle changes as per their needs. Beneficiaries with irregular blood pressure, diabetes and gastric troubles were temporarily given medicines for three or four days. Four beneficiaries were identified for cataract surgery and one among them was taken to the hospital that same day to complete the tests and surgery. The entire treatment was to be given for free. And the others will be taken later according to the convenience of the beneficiaries. The ideal part of the day was that the community people got to optimally use the free camp facility that was provided. The community was satisfied with the activities and performances of the trainees. The second day was very important because it would get a lot more attention from the public than the first day. The trainees were all equally participating in the camp. The hospital closed their camp by 02:00 PM. The trainees then dispersed for lunch. Post lunch, the trainees mobilised for the next day's program. Almost 95 people from the community made use of the camp and benefited from it in several ways. The trainees left the camp site by around 04:00 PM.
76. Day 3 – 19/03/2023 – Impact of Child Marriage and Importance of Education: The team reached the camp location by 10:00 AM. The day's schedule was to conduct engaging games for children of all age groups in the community. All the trainees split into several groups and left to mobilize and inform the villagers about the activities to be conducted for the day. The trainees asked the community people to gather in the playground by 10:45 AM for the events of the day. The events began with a small dance show by one of the trainees Mr. Veera Kumar. The children were eagerly dancing along with the trainee and eventually it ended up as a game in itself. The planned games for the day included frog jump race, balloon busting competition, kick the target and sundarikku pottu thodal. Each game was

conducted in two rounds to decide on a final winner for each category. The games were conducted one after the other. The rules and regulations of the games were explained to the children. The trainees showed a demo of each game for better understanding. All the kids thoroughly enjoyed and actively participated in the respective events of their choices. After two games the children were provided with refreshment by the trainees. All the games closed before noon and the crowd dispersed for lunch. Post noon, Team Rebels from Hindustan College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore graced the stage with a dance performance. Their coordination and energy were eccentric which pulled the crowd's entire attention. Followed by this performance was another classical dance performance by a trainee Mr. Arvin Krishna. The chief guest for the day was Mrs. Saranya, Director of the Leader's Desk, Coimbatore. After the cultural events, the chief guest spoke to the community and the trainees about the importance of education. She pointed out the impact's education can have on a child and how it will empower children, especially girls. She spoke about how empowering a girl child would end up empowering the entire family and eventually the entire nation. The day moved to its closing phase with the prize distribution. The winners of various competitions were awarded prizes by the chief guest. She was felicitated by Dr. M N Krishnadas, Assistant Professor, PG Department of Social Work. That marked the end of the day's events.

77. Day 4 – 20/03/2023 – Women Empowerment and Development: The trainees of I MSW reached the camp location by 10:00 AM on March 20, 2023, and started inviting women in the village of Ikkarai boluvampatti to take part in games that were planned specially for them for the day. By 11:00 AM, the village people had gathered at the camp location, and the trainees conducted various games for the women in the village, such as musical chairs, rangolis, and lucky corners. People of the village participated with enthusiasm by forgetting their usual days, as it made every woman cheerful. Women from different age groups were participating while the trainees and the staff cheered for the villagers. Then the gathering dispersed for lunch. Post lunch, the chief guest of the day, Dr. Meera, Director of CORD NGO, Coimbatore arrived, and the people of the village and students gathered for the session about women's empowerment and development. During the session, she spoke about how self-help groups helped the women in the village by empowering them and educating them about the various loans that are provided by the banks for the self-help group members. The members of the self-help group spoke about the benefits they have received from being members of the self-help group of the CORD NGO, and another member of the group Ms. Shuba shared about how their lives were before and after joining the self-help group. Ms. Vasanthi who works PHC spoke about the health conditions of the people in the village. The chief guest also spoke about the Magaleer Mandram that were established in the village. The members of the self-help group introduced the trainees to the ledger they maintain. They had taken loans of about 20 lakhs so far from various sources and used them for various needs. The women from magaleer mandram have learned vocational jobs and are now supporting their family financially. They even mentioned about how people in the village broke away from open defecation with the help of Dr. Meera and CORD NGO. Then the trainees were asked to share the aids that they had done for the people in their lives, and each trainee shared the invaluable aids they had done for the people and got appreciation from the chief guest

and the people from the village. After that, prizes for the winners of each game were distributed by the chief guest, and she ended the session by requesting everyone not to use plastic bags, gift wraps and not to burn tree leaves, which may cause cancer.

78. Day 5 – 21/03/2023 – Alcoholic addiction: On day five, the events were focused on the male population in the community. The primary idea was to conduct games followed by an awareness talk about the consumption of alcohol. The trainees reached Ikkarai Boluvampatti by 10:30 AM. As soon as the trainees reached the destination, a small group meeting was held to discuss with the trainees about the activities planned for the day. Then, the trainees went for mobilisation; but unlike the other days the response wasn't that welcoming and there weren't enough target community people as it was a working day. Still there were three to four men who came to be a part of the day. People from Anbaran deaddiction centre and Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) group were the guest speakers for the day. AA is a group that began in United States of America in 1935. Anbaran is a deaddiction centre working for the alcoholics and other drug addicts. Mrs. Mythili from Anbaran deaddiction centre spoke from her experience about the ill effects of alcohol on an individual and in turn their family. She also educated the audience about how one could lead a better life if stayed away from alcohol. It was followed by a small talk from Mrs. Lakshmi. She shared her views on alcohol consumption and the negative effects it could have on people's life. There were four members representing AA and all of them shared how important it is that a person should not be an alcoholic. They spoke about how it will not only destroy his/her life but also of everyone who is near and dear to them. Mr. Antony Vijay Anand from AA, who was once an alcoholic and separated from that life, addressed the gathering and spoke about the life he had and the life he is living now. After that, the trainees dispersed for lunch. Mr. Sethusakthi and his family have sponsored for the lunch that day. After lunch the trainees had spent some quality time in and around the village observing the people in the community. Volunteers from National Service Scheme had visited the same area for their camp purposes. The take away from that day was knowing the fact that alcoholism is a disease. It is a disease which cannot be treated with medicine but by tuning one's mind accordingly. The guests who came from AA reinforced that a person trying to recover alone is hard but it becomes easy when similar people come together and work as a group. The importance of group therapies has been spoken about.
79. Day 6 – 22/03/2023 – Organic Farming: On day 6 the trainees reached the camp site by 10:00 AM. A talk and discussion on organic farming was scheduled for the day. The guest speaker for the day was Mr. Thangavel, an organic farmer. The trainees began mobilising the target community, farmers and farm related daily wage labourers for an hour. Organic farming, also known as ecological farming or biological farming, is an agricultural system that uses fertilizers of organic origin such as compost manure, green manure, and bone meal and places emphasis on techniques such as crop rotation and companion planting. The speaker began his talk by comparing organic farming with modern day farming. Firstly, organic produces are healthier than the HYV and synthetic one's and also carry longer shelf life. The speaker mentioned that the cost of organic farming is reduced as there is no need to buy synthetic fertilizers and manures. Organic farming also increases the fertility of the soil thus providing longer yields than the synthetic one's. The speaker shared few tips with the audience on how they can practice organic farming in day-to-day life with the things at hand. He also shared his

experience from travelling across the state of Tamil Nadu and researching about organic farming practices. The audience were very interactive and asked few more tips on how to lead a healthy life and the speaker was more than happy to answer them. He requested the audience to try and practice organic farming at least on roof tops for the betterment of the human community as a whole. He was felicitated by Dr. A Alagarsamy, Head of PG Department of Social Work, Sri Krishna Arts and Science College, Coimbatore – 08. In the meantime, few trainees attended Gram Sabha meeting of the Ikkarai Boluvampatti Panchayat along with the volunteers of National Service Scheme. Gram Panchayat is a basic village-governing institute in Indian villages. It is a democratic structure at the grass-roots level in India. It is a political institute, acting as cabinet of the village. The Gram Sabha work as the general body of the Gram Panchayat. The members of the Gram Panchayat are elected directly by the people. Each gram panchayat has a Sarpanch or a president who is elected and who convenes the meetings of gram sabha. Any person who is above the age of 18 is a member of gram sabha and can attend meetings convened by the sarpanch. The trainees attended the meeting in order to gain an exposure to the conduct of the village level institutions. The gram sabha members were very welcoming and appreciated the trainees for the involvement. During the lunch break, few trainees got to interact with the kids in the community and their responses were over whelming. It was evident from the way they spoke that they started to accept the trainees as members among their community and were sharing their experiences. The trainees in turn spoke to them about the importance of life skills and how they could use opportunities available to them to lead a better life. There was a sense of satisfaction among the trainees. By around 03:00 PM the trainees left the campsite to visit Adiyogi Shiva Statue. It is a statue of Lord Shiva located at the foothills of Velliangiri hills in Western Ghats. The statue holds a Guinness world record for being the largest bust sculpture. The trainees also visited the Dhiyanalinga and Linga Bhairavi abodes built by Isha Foundation, Coimbatore. This visit apart from being a field trip helped in improving the bond among the trainees. The trainees left the place by 06:30 PM.

80. Day 7 – 23/03/2023 – Waste Management and Sanitation Awareness: On the final day, the trainees reached the camp site by around 10:30 AM. For the last day, awareness on waste management and sanitation was scheduled. Mr. Akhil, community developer from Westric Trust was the chief guest for the day. After mobilising for an hour, the trainees gathered around to listen to the talk of the chief guest. Waste management refers to the process of collection, segregation, processing, recycling and monitoring of waste products that are generated in the community. Wastes can be biodegradable and non-biodegradable. The guest speaker mentioned the process that is involved in recycling the non-biodegradable wastes. He also brought out the importance of segregating the wastes from source and how it will ease out the further process. Plastics that are below 40 microns cannot be recycled no matter what. From his experience he said that, those wastes would be crushed and used for constructions such as roads. He pointed out the system that is in existence in the lower institutions and how inefficient it is. He also told that about 20% of the total waste collected on average could never be touched for further processing as every type of wastes would be mixed. He discussed few ways of making money from the wastes and encouraged the trainees to take up waste management. He requested the trainees to convey the message of segregating the waste

from source and handing them over to the concerned person to the community as much as possible. Waste management would be a huge problem if it is uncontained and if the present situation continues. He was felicitated by Dr. M N Krishnadas. The trainees then prepared Pongal and concluded the camp with some music and dance. The trainees left the camp site by 03:00 PM.

81. **Transect Walk** - In the morning session, students began the program with a transect walk in the area. Students accumulated the details about the area and invited the people for the camp inauguration ceremony. Observed the community fully and the resources which they are available. The 7 days tribal camp for II MSW was officially inaugurated by Mr. Senthil Kumar the Assistant Conservator of Forest of Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu. Kittusamy (President), Jaya Kumar (Ward counselor), Kanagaraj (Social activist), Ram kumar (Siruvani vizhuthugal Coordinator), Mr. Susendranath (Forest Ranger officer), Mr. Ranjith (Forester of Department of Forest of Tamil Nadu) are the other guests for the day. The total participation for the morning session is 13 community members. Mohanapriya madam read the description of camp and gave an idea about the purpose, objectives and activities for the seven days camp to the community people. Among the community, a person gave a suggestion for a computer skill development workshop for the local children. Total numbers of participants in the morning session are 24 community members. Forest and Health - With the resource person Mr. Senthil Kumar alone with the community people all students observed the importance of biodiversity, and the way to maintain different species. Resource person talked about the tribal communities in India, Bhil is the largest tribal community in India and the president of India belongs to the third largest tribal community. India's total population belongs to 9% tribes. In Coimbatore within forest nearly 5000 tribal people are there. It was a completely interactive session by the students and locals with the resource person. Personally, many participants clarified their various doubts and received relevant answers for the valued questions.
82. The second day of the camp program was held by the department of social work, Sri Krishna College of Arts and Science, which organized a Tribal camp in Seengapathy, Chadivayal near Kovai Kutralam, Coimbatore. The place was also occupied by the Irula tribal community with an approximate population of 177 people. The II-year MSW students gathered and conducted a program on the topic of "FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSION". The resource person was Dr. Umashankar who has given us practical knowledge of focus group discussion. We have also conducted drawing competitions for the tribal children and other cultural activities along with the community people and the facilities. Focused Group Discussion - Focused group discussion was carried out with Seengapathy tribal people. Dr. G. Umashankar, Former Director, Jan sikshan sansthan, Coimbatore was the chief guest. Firstly, he gave an explanation about the pattern of Focussed Group and its various steps and the things that social workers want to learn. The need assessment, resource mobilization of the tribes and reason for the unemployment is found out with the help of focused group discussion, that will help the students to get a clear idea of the people's thoughts, feelings, and the in- depth information is collected in a very short time. As a social worker, while starting the Focussed Group Discussion, initially want to break the distance between the social workers and the villagers and want to make them into a comfort zone. Later start to build the rapport with the community people through asking the basic questions or history of the community which they know or are able to give the answers. 23 members from the community participate in this session.

83. The Department of Social Work organized a women entrepreneurship development program for the kalkothipathy tribal people on 23.3.2023, as a part of Tribal camp during the third day. Mudugas tribal community is one of the indigenous tribal communities living in the kalkothipathy, at the foothills of western Ghats. Ms. S. Deepika, student of II MSW have given hands - on training to the people on mat making and artificial flower tying. The community people actively took part in the activity because they will be engaged in seasonal employment only. As a part of the camp, a session was conducted on Rain water harvesting and Environmental Protection to commemorate world meteorological day 2023. The session was chaired by Dr. Kamaraj, Director, NERD NGO, Coimbatore. Even though they are living in foothills the village is facing the water scarcity problem, so the Chief guest also insisted on protection of the environment. Case study method is employed to promote student engagement through active learning process and discussion was carried out. Handcraft workshop - Deepika, a student among us is an expert in making handcrafted materials with used objects or torn out cloths. We made this an opportunity and appointed Deepika to take on the workshop for the community people. The people in the community are coolie workers and they were not able to work on a daily basis. So, extra self-help work can be helpful for them. This was our concept behind this program. The community people have totally made use of the program. She showed them how to make floor mats and plastic flowers.
84. Students conducted a Tobacco Awareness program as a part of a fourth-day activity of the Tribal camp at Nallurpathy. Mr. Murali Krishnan, social worker, Department of public health, Coimbatore initiated a Rally and the students chanted slogans to make the community people know about the ill effects of the usage of tobacco. As today is world TB Day, guests also pointed out that smoking increase the risk of contracting Tuberculosis. Dr. S. Rajkumaari, Assistant professor, Department of Psychology, Government arts college, Coimbatore chaired the second session emphasizing subjective well-being and she pointed out the importance of personality, confidence, and a sense of belongingness to the tribal community people and the students. The 4 team members were preparing the rally board for rally walk to create awareness about Tuberculosis disease and the usage of Tobacco. Students were actively involved in the rally walk.
85. Department of social work, Sri Krishna Arts and Science College, Coimbatore organized a programme on Employment and Career guidance to the Tribal students. Mr. C. Subramaniam, Assistant Director, SC/ST Employment and Career guidance center, District employment office, Coimbatore was the chief guest for the programme. He insisted about the importance of education and employment, he gave the tips for Preparing the competitive examination to the students. Along with the District employment office conducted a camp to register the qualifications of the students (TN Employment registration), during the camp seven students have completed the registration and for two students' renewal process is carried out.
86. Sri Krishna Arts and Science College, Department of Social work organized a one-day workshop on Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) during the 6th day Tribal Camp at Nallurpathy, Coimbatore. The session was handled by Dr.S.Udhaya kumar , Community organizer, Tamil Nadu urban habitat Development Board, Coimbatore. The students learned about the social mapping, seasonal Diagram, Mobility

mapping, Resource mapping, Venn diagram, problem tree, pie chart, process Diagram and the various techniques were employed by the students to access the problem and need of the community. It makes the students to develop the new strategies and transfer the appropriate community knowledge for the grassroots action with the help of the Community people.

87. Students attended a one-day workshop on the topic "Theatre and Art" as the final day programme of camp 2023. The workshop was led by Ms.Chandramathi Ramaswamy, A research scholar in Social Work, Bharathiyar University and an experienced drama artist. She has been working with theatre for more than a decade. She was accompanied by Ms.Tamilpirai, a talented drama artist and Chemistry research scholar, Bharathiyar University. They both made the team use different kinds of emotions to express the problems, needs and diversities in the community. Theatre is an important part of social work. Especially street play or a skit play. It represents the society and the interventions of the problems the society face. Art is always used for the easy understanding and projecting problems a community deal with. It is not merely a speech or a story, it enacts what it means. Therefore, each and every student was obliged to perform their own and express what they feel inside. In the beginning of the workshop, students were told to keep a few rules regarding the behavior they have to follow throughout the session. 1) Value the speaker 2) Touch with respect. Session was further moved on to breathing exercises and voice enhancement therapy. Students were divided into two sides and one of them got to be the images and the other was mirrors. Mirrors should enact what the image shows. This exhibited the talent of many to imitate someone to reflect their actions. After the basic orientation, the guest divided the students into 5 groups and allotted them with different themes. 1) Patriarchy 2) Casteism 3) Child Labour 4) LGBTQ 5) Workplace Harassment. Students practiced the plays and performed in the afternoon session. Each and every team was evaluated and pointed out their appreciations and drawbacks.
88. Department of Electronics and Communication Systems ECSNOVA Student Department Association Arts club conducted an online competition on Poster Designing Contest on "Noble Women" on 04th March 2023. Prof. Lavanya. G, Association In-charge was the event Coordinator. A total of 05 students got participated in the Competition.
89. Department of Electronics and Communication Systems organized a Workshop on "VLSI Design" on 07th March 2023. The resource person of the programme is Mr. Aasaithambhi Durairajan, Lead Engineer Sr, Qualcomm India PVT Ltd, Bangalore. Dr. S. Shankar, Assistant professor, Department of Electronics and Communication Systems is the event Coordinator & Prof. Lavanya. G, Department of Electronics and Communication Systems, Sri Krishna Arts and Science College is the Association In-charge. A total of 31 students got participated in the programme.
90. Department of Electronics and Communication Systems ECSNOVA Student Department Association Sports club conducted a "Chess Competition" on 11th March 2023. Prof. Lavanya. G, Association In-charge was the event Coordinator. A total of 14 students got participated in the Competition.
91. Department of Electronics and Communication Systems ECSNOVA Student Department Association organized & conducted ECSNOVA utsav 2023 – A One day State Level Intercollegiate Technical Symposium & ECSNOVA Department Association Valedictory

on 31st March 2023. Mr. M. Senthil Kumar, CEO Co-founder, Jiovio Healthcare, Madurai was the resource person who inaugurated the programme and Signing of MoU was also done on the same day with Jiovio Healthcare, Madurai. Prof. Lavanya. G, Association In-charge & Dr. S.R. Vijayalakshmi, Association In-charge (Associate), Department of Electronics and Communication Systems, Sri Krishna Arts and Science College were the event convenors. A total of 103 Student Participants from various colleges across the state got participated in the Symposium.
