The Chairman of the Board of Studies welcomed the members for the meeting. The members took up the agenda for the meeting. The Chairman of the Board of Studies submitted the Scheme and Syllabus of 2023 – 2024 batch UG – B.A. English Literature and PG – M.A. English Literature as approved by Curriculum Development Cell (CDC) for the First and Second Semesters for the discussion and approval.

The following are the highlights of the Curriculum introduced from the year 2023 – 2024. All the Courses are grouped under five categories.

- Group I - AEC – Ability Enhancement Courses – 10 Courses with 24 credits
- Group II -DSC – Discipline Specific Courses – 15 Courses with 60 credits
- Group III -DSE – Discipline Specific Electives – 10 Courses with 40 credits
- Group IV -GEC – General Elective Courses – 4 Courses with 12 credits
- Group V – SEC – Skill Enhancement Courses – 2 Courses with 4 credits
- Group VI - ANCC – Audit Non-Credit Courses– 3 Courses with Nil credits
