- The meeting commenced at 10.30 am with a welcome address by the Chairperson.
- The following members have informed the inability to attend, due to official engagement

The Committee recorded his leave of absence.

- The Committee recorded the minutes of the previous Governing Body meeting held on 29th October 2022 and the action taken based on the suggestions given in the meeting. The minutes and the action taken were approved.
- The Chairperson requested the principal to present a report on the activities in the college from the last Governing Body meeting till date.
- The Principal presented the report and the highlights are as follows
 - a. The present student strength of the college is 8136.
 - b. The present faculty strength of the college is 275 with 113 Ph.D holders, 27 NET cleared, 24 SET cleared.
 - c. During the academic year 2022-2023, 2706 students got 2359 offers in various multi-national and national level companies till 04.05.2023
 - d. The following are the details of rankings attained in 2022
 - i. NIRF Ranking – 33rd in College Category
 - ii. Institution Innovation Council (IIC) – 4 Star Rating.
 - iii. Week Magazine – All India 34th position among commerce colleges.
 - iv. NPTEL
 - a. Valuable Local Chapter with A rating.

- The Principal detailed about the seed grant allocation and incentives given to the faculty for the research and academic performances.
- The Principal recorded the activities and initiatives taken in entrepreneurship, IPR and Startup themes under the pre-incubation unit.
- The general body ratified the appointment of 20 faculty members based on the sanctioned workload and the body also ratified the resignation of 17 faculty members from the last meeting to till date.

- The Principal also placed on record the minutes of Academic Council, Board of Studies, Statutory and Non – Statutory Committee meetings under autonomous Scheme held during this period.
- The committee recorded the minutes.
- The Principal also presented the results of the Odd Semester Examination held during December 2022. The results were recorded.
- The College has planned to conduct Internal Audit in May 2023 and External Audit in June 2023.

- The details of scholarships provided by Government, Management and other NGOs were recorded.
- The Outreach Programmes conducted by NSS,NCC,YRC and other clubs on Social Awareness, Health and Hygiene, Cleaning Environment Activities were presented and recorded.
- A Feedback mechanism was detailed by the Principal. The Mechanism involves collecting feedback from students, parents, alumni, industry HR people and subject experts about the curriculum, teaching learning methodology, evaluation, placements and other facilities. The responses were interpreted statistically and the action taken report was recorded.
- The report on the strategic future plan and the road map of the college, Implementation of NEP, Extension of Autonomy, Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), Increase Number of Patents and Publications, provide more placement opportunities, establish collaborations with industries and inculcate startup and entrepreneurship culture were placed and recorded.
- The Chairperson recommended the three faculty members (as per Annexure) are to be promoted as Associate Professor under Career Advancement Scheme as per the norms.
- Resolved to promote the 3 faculty members as per the Annexure and redesignate them as Associate Professor from 1st June 2023.
- Resolved to take additional intake of Ph.D and M.Phil scholars as per Bharathiar University norms.

- The Chairperson and Managing Trustee suggested implementing of civil service academy, website updation and research improvements.
- Dr.K.P.Suresh suggested the following
 - To introduced new Post Graduate programmes
 - To increase full time research scholars
 - To enhance seed money for research
 - To introduce NEP four year honours programme
 - Faculty and students exchange programme in top university
 - To conduct Institutional I tech integrating teacher education programme.
 - To update website
- Mr.Jayakumar Ramadass suggested the following
 - To include alumni fees in admission and give recognition to alumnus
 - To improve in NAAC Score and NIRF Ranking
 - To give equal opportunity for differently abled students
 - Increase pass percentage of students
- Mr.Nandha Kumar insisted to concentrate in result area and suggested to improve in placements.
- Dr. E. Chandra suggested the following
 - To increase research guides
 - To file more patents
 - To introduce PG Diploma Courses
- The Chairperson suggested that the next Governing Body meeting will be held in October 2023.
