

General Suggestions:

- Mr. S. Ganesan, Head Education Initiatives, Logistics Sector Skill Council, appreciated
 the new curriculum structure and syllabi, suggested to conduct one week crash courses on
 life skills, morality etc and asked to connecting local demands & opportunities as National
 & Global.
- Mr. N. Sampath Kumar, Head, Training and Development, Roots Industries India Ltd, appreciated the innovative practices and he highly commended the academic growth which ensures the present needs. He insisted to guide the students in improving their communication skills as it gives them confidence to meet the requirements to the interview sessions. He gave suggestion that Pandemic periods learning should be compensated, and discussed that Fundamental & Conceptual knowledge is missing, Etiquette was totally missing among the students and appreciated the concept of Skill Card, Academic Skills Course, Capstone Project.
