

NSS | Volunteering for Differently Abled Personalities in Exhibition with Swadharma Foundations














NSS | Blood Donation Camp

NSS | Temple Cleaning


















Bioscience | Inauguration




Mathematics | Expert Talk








Commerce CA & BA | Alumni Interaction





MSW | Workshop










SKASC | Student Council Meeting








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Commerce | Competition & Expo

This event highlighted the significance of GST, a transformative Tax reform introduced in India on July 1, 2017.



The School of Commerce organized a session on 'Gemba Walk with Leaders' on July 2, 2024, for its office bearers and class representatives.






Campaign | B.Sc. ISM & BBA Logistics





CT & DS | SEMINAR



CDF | WORKSHOP







B.Com. A & F / M.Com. IB | Soft Skill Program



International Conference Bioscience




Signing of an MoU | BBA

Industrial Visit | CSHM










