- Mr. M. Senthil, Lead Technical Trainer, ICT Academy.




FDP-Cloud Practitioner

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


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



Blood donation is a critical need in healthcare, and by stepping up during an emergency, the NSS volunteers demonstrated true compassion and leadership.


NSS – Art Project in Government School




Student Induction Program | Health & Hygiene










SEMINAR | MSW
