


Placement Cell | Pre-Placement Talk






Placement | Visit to Aaludra Technology Solutions


Career Guidance Cell | Expert Seminar




SKASC | Teacher's Day Celebrations






B.Com. PA & CS | Guest Lecture










Recruitment Drive | Placement



Orientation Program | BPS & BI



Guest Lecture | Computer Science




