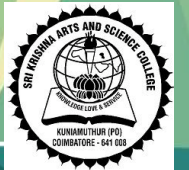

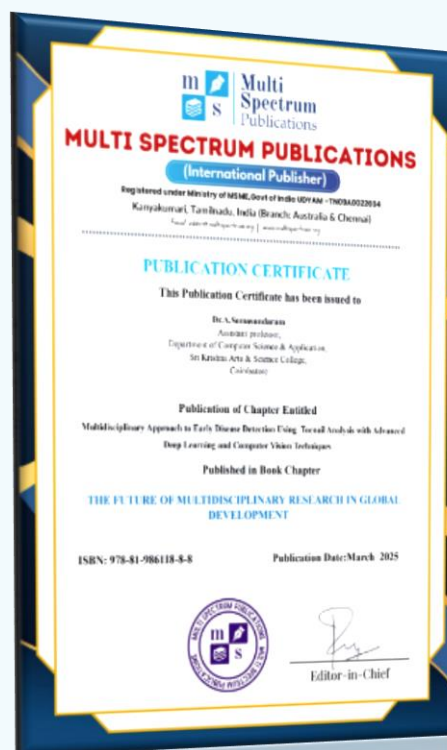
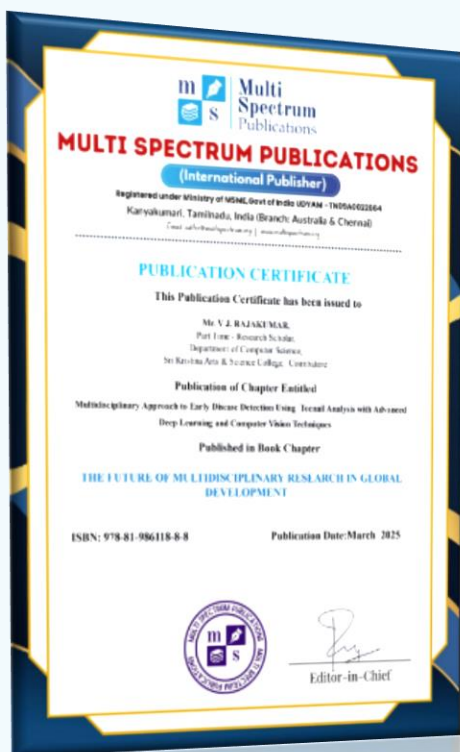


# MSW | Awareness Program
