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
## **Placement Achievements**

SKASC congratulates 52 students who were placed as **Analyst**Trainees at Cognizant with an annual package of ₹2.52 lakhs.






# **SKASC I DIGILOCKER**





# **MANAGEMENT | FACULTY ACHIEVEMENT**




